Credit Report Security Freeze

Beginning January 1, 2007, consumers living in states Hawaii, Kansas, New Hampshire, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, and Wisconsin will be able to put a security freeze on their credit file. Over 30 states now allow the consumer to place a security freeze on their credit file.

If a consumer has requested a Security Freeze on his credit file, no information will be returned to the company requesting the credit file. The consumer credit file can now only be viewed once the consumer contacts one of the three national credit reporting agencies and requests the FREEZE be removed.
